A Letter from the President

As each year goes by, I am proud to experience each one of our sponsored children in the program we give a grant to and how they have grown just a little bit more because of our help. Some of the scholars started the scholarship program when they were 13 years old and they are now going to start their last year of high school in 2008. I talk to them and they have expectations to continue their education to university so this assures me we have done a proper job supporting this project.

2007 was a very good year and we started it with a fundraiser event that helped us raise 30% of our total income of the year. Included in this percentage are the funds of a new sponsor who was new to our organization and signed up to support our social responsibility.



Our sponsor list grew by 60% compared to 2006 allowing us to have at least one minimum payment sponsor per child at the Cordoba program. Out of all the sponsors we have one from abroad supporting our cause.

We have applied to get tax exempt status from the IRS. Once granted, this will allow our sponsors and donators to deduct their donations from their taxes and it will make it easy for GO to receive donations from corporations.

Along 2007 we have incorporated 2 new volunteers who are committed to actively work with us and donate their time and knowledge.

We hope to continue working hard for our children and we know that only by increasing capacity we will be able to help more children each year. It is all about helping each other to help others that we will accomplish this goal.
